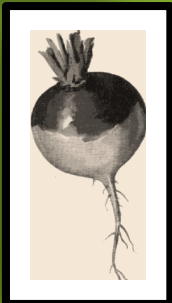

Sierra Bounty Produce Collective promotes a thriving local food system! The support of our members make it possible to manage overhead expenditures for our role as intermediary; such as fuel for deliveries, packaging materials and standard business operating costs.

Your support allows Sierra Bounty to foster an enduring relationship between local farmers and ranchers and their community.

Sierra Bounty Produce Collective is currently a status pending non-profit organization that coordinates the sale of produce between local farms and buyers. Individuals, grocers, and restaurants place orders for seasonally available produce online; the corresponding purchases are then made through the organization among a local network of farms, and the goods are delivered to the buyer.

Sierra Bounty is also a leader in promoting grassroots efforts to enhance the ecological, social, and economic sustainability of local agriculture.

Sierra Bounty's role is to ensure that growers receive a fair price for their goods and that buyers are not overcharged in their efforts to support local agriculture. We envision supply and demand growing together as growers, businesses, and individual consumers benefit from this new market sector.

Goals for Sierra Bounty

- Introduce local produce to restaurants and stores
- Coordinate advance sales of local produce delivery to single-family residences
- Establish a Slow Food chapter for the Eastern Sierra
- Obtain grant funding for grower growth and sustainability assistance programs
- Develop community garden including education outreach program
- Extend access to CSA produce shares to include low-income families
- Seek approval for the sale of local dairy products by USDA
- Launch Farm to School program for local k-12
- Acquire and operate mobile slaughterhouse unit in the Eastern Sierra
